II. ABOUT THE PROJECT

Project category:

The project comes under the Category B, Activity 1(a), (i) of Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 and subsequent amendments.

b. Project location:

Sy. No. 369/2 at Koppam Village, Pattambi Taluk, Palakkad District, Kerala State. The proposed project site falls within N 10°50'37.2" to N 10°50'42.5" E 76°12'31.3" to E 76°12'30.7".

c. Project extent and activity:

The project is for quarrying of 43,000 TPA of building stone from an area of 2.1224 hectares of land located as specified above.

d. Project description:

The proposed project activity involves about 100 % of the pit area for exploring building stone. At the end of life of mine, excavated pit will be fully reclaimed and rehabilitated by plantation. The proposed project does not involve any underground mining activities. The mining is done by open cast semi mechanized method.

- 5.1. The location of the industry/out let shall be as per the approved drawing attached. Quarrying area is restricted to the land having valid lease in survey 369/2 for 2.1224 hectares in Koppam village, Pattambi Taluk. This consent is granted based on Environmental clearance No. DIA/KL/PL/4/2017 dated 29/07/2017. File No.E/2703/16/DEIAA issued by District environmental impact authority Palakkad and Letter of intent No 1622/M3/2017 from mining and geology director dated 15/02/2017.
- 5.2. This consent unless withdrawn earlier shall be valid up to 31/07/2020. If the operation of the quarry is to be continued after 31/07/2020 fresh application has to be submitted through online site krocmms.nic.in along with valid lease/permit from Department of Mining & Geology, 3 months in advance.
- 5.3. After excavation at the site is completed, the land may be reclaimed or used for rain water harvesting with protective barriers/any other suitable purpose like aquaculture approved by the authority.
- 5.4 The consent issued is subject to the conditions specified in the clearances issued by the Mining and Geology Department and Explosive Department as per the provisions of the relevant statutes.
- 5.5 It is the responsibility of occupier to ensure that quarrying activities are restricted to only area shown in the attached drawing and at a distance more than 100 m from the nearby residences and public roads having vehicular traffic .
- 5.6 All the control measures provided should be maintained properly to ensure that the system is adequate to control the pollution caused.
- 5.7 A minimum distance of 100m shall be maintained from the boundary of quarry operation area to existing residential buildings, places of worship, public buildings, public road having vehicular traffic, river or lake, railway line and bridges.
- 5.8 Boundary of quarrying area shall be fenced and demarcated.
- 5.9 Fugitive emission from the quarry premises shall be suppressed using water sprinkling.

- 5.11 Regular wetting of the roads in the premises of the quarry and approach roads near the quarry shall be done for avoiding dust emission within and outside the boundary of the unit.
- 5.12 It is the responsibility of occupier to ensure that quarrying activities are restricted to only area shown in the attached drawing and at a distance more than 100 m from the nearby residences and public roads having vehicular traffic .



5.13 The sound level measured at 1.0m outside the boundary shall not exceed the limit as per the Ambient Air Quality Standards in respect of Noise.

5.14 The validity of this consent may change subjected to the order of the Honorable Supreme Court/High Court / NGT in related cases, or the new orders issued by the government or other competent authority.

5.15 The consent issued from the Board will be valid only during the period when statutory or necessary clearances from other concerned authorities are valid. The consent issued from the Board is only with respect to the powers vested under the Water Act, 1974, Air Act, 1981 and Rules there under. The operation of the unit shall be commenced only after obtaining clearances from all concerned authorities.

5.19 Arrangement for rain water harvesting in the unit shall be done within one month for meeting the entire water requirement of quarry and crusher and the same shall be reported in writing within 35 days. All other conditions of the Integrated Consent to Operate issued as per reference above remain unchanged.

5.20 This consent may be granted on the basis of affidavit and other documents furnished by the applicant. Any of the statement or information found to be false, the consent issued will withdrawn or cancelled.

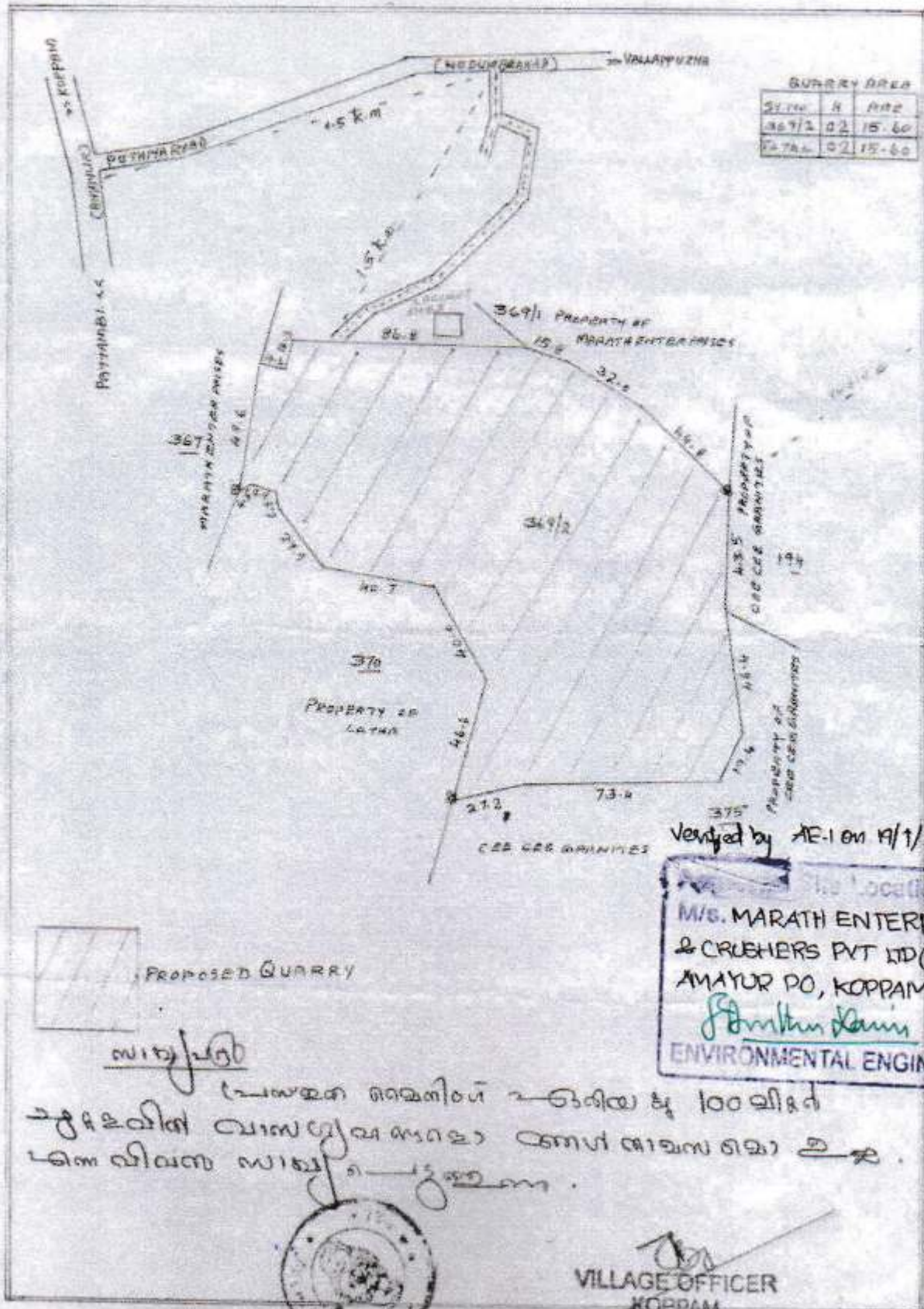

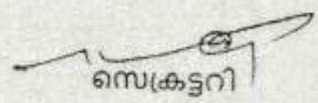

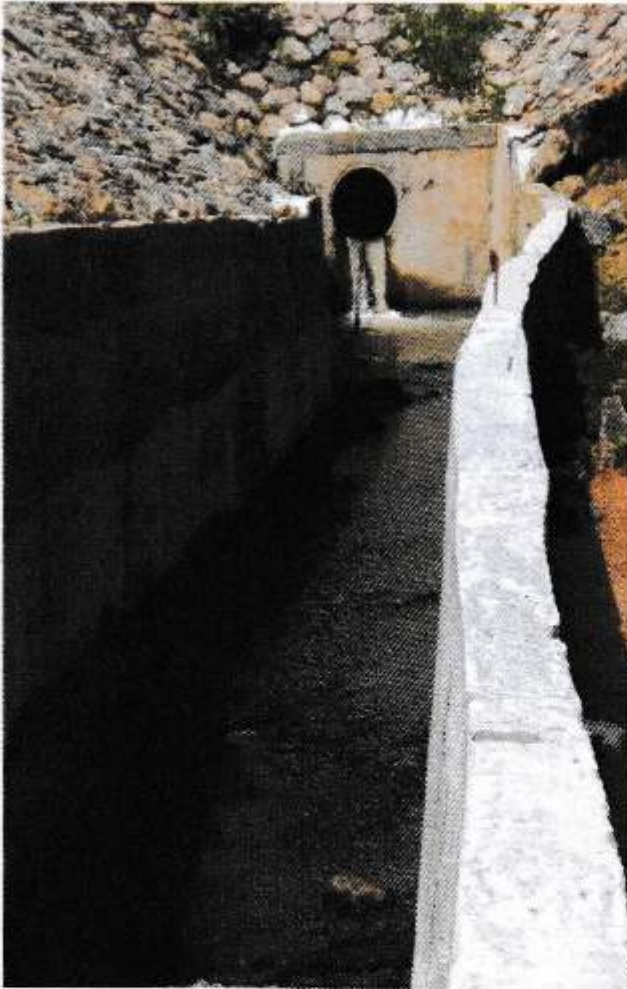
